You can help increase a child's self-esteem by providing one-to-one attention. We believe in forming strong, healthy relationships with our children.

There has been a change in our licensing as it relates to volunteers working with children: All volunteers working with children in a preschool setting will need to be vaccinated for **Influenza** (opt out option / 1 yr exp), **Pertussis** (10 year exp) and **Measles** (no exp), as well as a **negative TB test** (4 yr exp).
